

In this game, there are only two dealer cards involved and all guests can place chips on the different bets.
The game is played with one deck of cards so you do not necessarily need an automatic card shuffler!


The player bets on the sum of the two dealer cards. The card values correspond to the BlackJack game except the Ace, which always counts as 11.
If the sum 7 is made, then all three chances win.
House advantage:
4-14: 2.87\%
15-18 or the sum 7: $3.17 \%$
19-22 or the sum 7: 4.07\%

## IST CARD OR 2ND CARD thergher

The player bets on which card is higher and places his bet on either Higher 1st Card or Higher 2nd Card.
The winning bet pays $1: 1$
The highest card is 7 which results in a card order as follows: 7, AS, K, Q, J, $10,9,8,6,5,4,3,2$.
If the player gets a 7 with his 1 st card, he always wins and gets his bet paid 3:2.
In the case of égalité (tie), except with sum 7, the bank wins.
House Advantage:
1,13\%


If the two drawn cards have the same colour, the player wins his bet 1:1.

## House advantage:

1.96\%


The player bets the two cards of the dealer are: $7+8$ or $8+7$. In this case, the bank pays 50:1.
If, in addition, they are of the same suit, the bank pays 150:1.
House advantage:
8.3\%
